

Confirmation Banner Assignment

This is a witness opportunity for eighth grade confirmation students at Holy Cross. May the verse you choose and the banner you make be an inspiration for your life!

1. Your Confirmation Banner should have the following:
 - A. Your name on the back;
 - B. Your life verse reference (book chapter: verse);
 - C. Words from the life verse on the front; and a
 - D. Design that matches the theme of the verse on the front.
 - E. Your design must be approved by Pastor Gimbel or DCE Meghan ahead of time. Please have a drawing (sketch) prepared by Wednesday, April 3.

2. Construction details and requirements:
 - A. The required size is 27 inches wide by 48 inches long. Include another two inches if you would like to add a loop for a dowel. Please do not add the dowel until after the banners are displayed at church.
 - B. Letters should be at least 2 inches or larger.

3. Materials: Cloth, burlap, felt, glue, thread, iron-on, etc. Please do not use glitter. **NOTE:** The body of the banner must be felt to stick on the brick walls in church.

4. The due date is Wednesday, April 24. The banners will be hung in the church for two weekends after they are completed, beginning on April 27 through confirmation on May 5. Please take your banner home with you on Confirmation Sunday, May 5, following the 10:30 service.

5. Holy Cross has many resources and materials from the banners over the years and is willing to help you get a start for your project as well as be a connection point to work with and share materials with other families.
