

The Incredibles

Supplies you will need:

- Movie
- Bible

Before you start

- Read through all of the discussion questions and Bible verses on your own.
- Mark each Bible verse with a bookmark so that you do not need to spend extra time looking them up later.
- Decide if you will read the Bible verses and say the prayer or if you will ask a family member to be in charge of those parts.

Watch the movie together as a family. When the movie is over, walk through the discussion questions together.

Read all of the Bible verses and make sure that each person has a chance to share.

Ask: What did you like about the movie?

Ask: Did you learn anything while watching this movie?

Ask: If you were a superhero, what would your super power be?

Say This: In the movie each character has some special gifts. The Bible also talks about special gifts.

Read: Matthew 25:14-30 - The Parable of the Talents

Say: In this parable (a parable is a story that teaches us a lesson), Jesus tells of a man going on a journey and decides to give his possessions to his slaves. So he calls them one by one and gives each of them a portion of his money according to their abilities. We often end up like the servant in verse 18 because we spend too much time trying to find out our “gifts,” but the master takes what the servant had been given and gives it to another person. What we don’t realize is that God has already entrusted us with something, it doesn’t matter what we do, we just need to do something about it.

Ask: What special gifts/abilities do you have?

Ask: How do you use these gifts?

Say: We can all learn something from “Dash.” He couldn’t wait to use his superpower! He had some struggles and got into some trouble here and there but Dash kept working and building his talent. We can use Dash as an example of faith.

Read: Matthew 19:13-14

Say: Jesus teaches us that the Kingdom of God is made up of children. God wants us to be like that, totally trusting Him, putting our faith completely in Him. Dash understood that he had a special Talent and he trusted that he could learn to use it. We also can trust that God has given us many gifts and abilities and he will give us the courage to use them as best as we can.

Prayer - Thank God for the special Gifts and Talents that He has given each person in your family. Ask God to help your family learn how to use their abilities to honor Him.
