

One of the ways that is done is to write in minor keys and use dissonant chords which give the music a dark foreboding sound. Yet through all of the darkness and suffering many composers still remind us of the hope and promise of the resurrection, and some of them do that on the very last chord of the song. If you attended the 7:00 pm service on Ash Wednesday you heard the choir's anthem use that effect, and Sunday morning's selection uses it again. Listen carefully for the change from sorrow to joy on the very last note of today's choir's anthem. *Soli Deo Gloria!*



The US CENSUS 2020 is just around the corner. St. Charles County officials encourage you to answer the Census. The Census determines how Federal funds are distributed and affects funding for public schools, healthcare, food programs, roads, public assistance, affordable housing and

other crucial services. Also, the Census determines political representation for our State. The goal of the 2020 Complete Count Commission for St. Charles County is to ensure that 100% of the County is included in the Census. Individuals can complete the Census by mail or phone, and, for the first time in 2020, will have the option of completing it online. Census staff also will go door-to-door in communities, distributing forms.

Census Timeline:

- March 12-20: An invitation to respond online to the 2020 Census will be sent in the mail. Some households also will receive paper questionnaires.
- ♦ March 16-24: A reminder letter will be sent.
- March 26-April 3: If you haven't responded yet, a reminder postcard will be sent.
- April 8-16: If you haven't responded yet, a reminder letter and paper questionnaire will be sent.
- April 20-27: If you haven't responded yet, a final reminder postcard will be sent before the Census Bureau follows up in person.
