## Happy Birthday Jesus!

Sunday School Students: You are invited to a Birthday Party for Jesus! This Sunday, Dec. 21, 2025 9:30-10:30AM

The Tech Board is sponsoring a **Smartphone and Tablet Collection Drive** from Sat., Dec. 20, 2025, to Sun., Jan. 4, 2026, to provide devices for Lutheran Deaf Outreach to use when traveling abroad. The devices must be less than 5 years old and capable of video conferencing. A collection box will be placed in the Welcome Center.

**MOTQ:** Currently, the Missions and Stewardship Boards are supporting Lutheran Early Response Team (LERT), a ministry program of the LCMS that trains volunteers to assist in times of disaster. These teams respond to both natural and man-made disasters by providing Christian care and assisting with cleanup, debris removal, and other essential services in affected communities. Several members of Holy Cross have attended LERT training in the past and have utilized the skills learned to support our community. All MOTQ donations from now through the beginning of 2026 will be used to help fund and support LERT projects.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT 2025 CONTRIBUTIONS**

The last day to submit contributions for Holy Cross for the 2025 calendar year is Wed., Dec. 31, 2025. All contributions received by end of business on that date (noon) will be included on the 2025 contribution statement. Donations hand delivered to the church by Tues., Dec. 31, or received via USPS with a postmark of 12/31/25 or before, will also be included on the 2025 contribution statement. Any contributions received on or after Thurs., Jan. 1, 2026, will be on the 2026 contribution statement.

Direct Up to Half of Your Missouri Taxes to Lutheran Schools: Through a fairly simple process, you can send half of your taxes to the State of Missouri to support a student in a Lutheran school. This will not save you money but also will not cost you additional dollars. If your Missouri State Tax on Line 36 last year was \$1,000, you could have sent \$500 to support a student in a Lutheran school and the other \$500 to the State of Missouri. This program began in 2022. Since then, the Missouri District has awarded over \$5 million in scholarships, helping more than 900 students attend 45 Lutheran schools across Missouri. Many of these children are experiencing their first year in a Lutheran school—an opportunity made possible through MOScholars.

# The Longest Might of the Year

The Christmas season can be a dark and lonely time for some. Here are 3 ways to spend time with the Light of the World.

Sit by your lit Christmas tree in the dark and repeat Psalm 139: 12

Take a walk outside and create a breath prayer. A breath prayer is a short, two-part prayer. One is a name for God: the second is a petition or request.

Here are some examples: "Loving Jesus, come quickly." "God of light, take away my fear." "Holy One, shine in my heart." Repeat the prayer throughout the walk

Sit in the darkness inside your home. Light the four candles on the Advent wreath and be completely silent for at least 1 minute. After the silence, have hot chocolate, sing a carol, or read Luke 1: 5 - 2:21.
