The Technology Board is sponsoring a **Smartphone and Tablet Collection Drive** from Sat., Dec. 20, 2025, to Sun., Jan. 4, 2026, to provide devices for Lutheran Deaf Outreach to use when traveling abroad. The devices must be less than 5 years old and capable of video conferencing. A collection box will be placed in the Welcome Center.

MOTQ: Currently, the Missions and Stewardship Boards are supporting Lutheran Early Response Team (LERT), a ministry program of the LCMS that trains volunteers to assist in times of disaster. These teams respond to both natural and man-made disasters by providing Christian care and assisting with cleanup, debris removal, and other essential services in affected communities. Several members of Holy Cross have attended LERT training in the past and have utilized the skills learned to support our community. All MOTQ donations from now through the beginning of 2026 will be used to help fund and support LERT projects.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT 2025 CONTRIBUTIONS

The last day to submit contributions for Holy Cross for the 2025 calendar year is Wed., Dec. 31, 2025.

All contributions received by end of business on that date (noon) will be included on the 2025 contribution statement. Donations hand delivered to the church by Tues., Dec. 31, or received via USPS with a postmark of 12/31/25 or before, will also be included on the 2025 contribution statement. Any contributions received on or after Thurs., Jan. 1, 2026, will be on the 2026 contribution statement.

Direct Up to Half of Your Missouri Taxes to Lutheran **Schools**: Through a fairly simple process, you can send half of your taxes to the State of Missouri to support a student in a Lutheran school. This will not save you money but also will not cost you additional dollars. If your Missouri State Tax on Line 36 last year was \$1,000, you could have sent \$500 to support a student in a Lutheran school and the other \$500 to the State of Missouri. This program began in 2022. Since then, the Missouri District has awarded over \$5 million in scholarships, helping more than 900 students attend 45 Lutheran schools across Missouri. Many of these children are experiencing their first year in a Lutheran school—an opportunity made possible through MOScholars. Pick up a colorful sheet entitled "Support Our LCMS Schools" and/or talk with David Schlesselman to learn more. Together we can help another child learn more about Jesus.

OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE THE HOMELESS: Holy Cross has been asked by the Emergency Weather Response agency for St. Charles, Lincoln, and Warren Counties about our providing a place to sleep for homeless people on extremely cold evenings. Our sister congregation, Chapel of the Cross, has been doing this for several years. They are looking for volunteers to help at their church during the weeks of Jan. 11, Jan. 25, and Feb. 22. We encourage interested members from Holy Cross to sign up for a couple of nights for one week to watch how it works. It could provide a great way for us at Holy Cross to assist homeless people in the future. A person would work one shift on an evening with two other people. Shifts are from 9-11PM, 11PM-3AM, and 3AM-7AM. Contact Jennie Bain at 636-288-3373 to sign up or ask more questions. 


Lutheran Education Tuition Assistance
